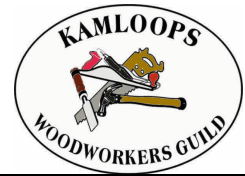

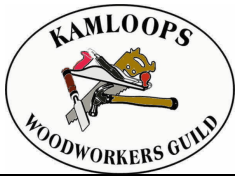
That the presented budget be accepted by the membership.

Gary Harker has put in an order for toy parts.

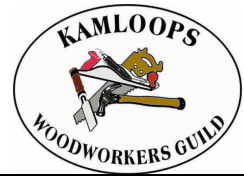
He has presented the Executive with an invoice in the amount of \$627.22 and some of the parts are on back order. The back order should be approx \$300.00.

Need volunteers?

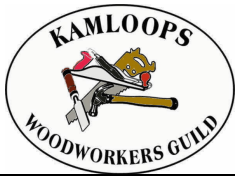
JUNE SEASON-END SOCIAL:

The year End Picnic and Social will be held on **June 07, 2008**.

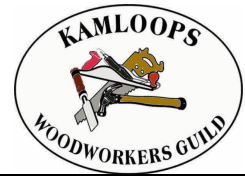
Dave Rawson will organize but is unable to be present on this date.

Table Derry's motion, and direct the Executive to search for further input and/or discussion before returning to the Membership with a recommendation.

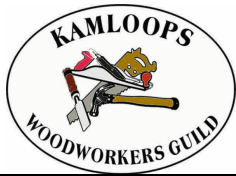
SHOW & TELL:

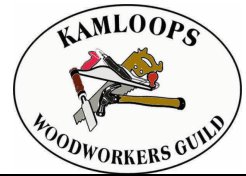

THE PRESIDENT'S CORNER:

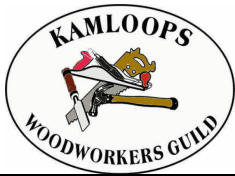
Some members voiced a concern at last general meeting that they weren't invited to the March Executive Meeting.

In the past the Executive Meetings have been open to the membership but due to the nature of the issues we were going to discuss I felt that the March meeting should be open only to the actual executive.

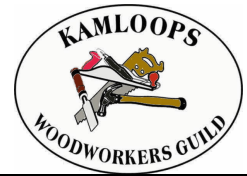
