Entries should not have been previously placed in any show and should have been completed within the past 12 months.

The entry fee will be \$5.00 if monies and registrations are tendered prior to or on Oct. 30, 2009. You are welcome to enter multiple entries.

A Late-Entry Fee of \$10.00 will be charged.

People's Choice Award—will be voted on by the public.

The Show Chairman and/or Judges reserve the right to change the entry to a more appropriate skill level, or may move an entry to another category deeming the entry meets the standard of that level or category.

The Show Chairman and/or Judges decision will be final.
