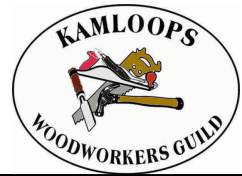

WELCOME TO THIS MONTH'S NEWSLETTER:

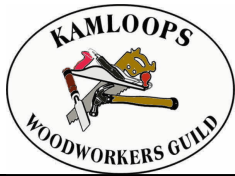

- Terry S introduced D. Dillmore as his guest.

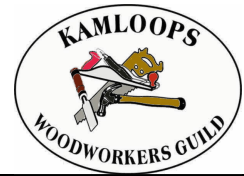
ANNOUNCEMENTS:

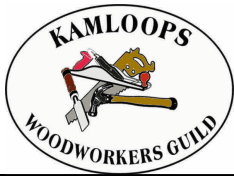

- Carl Ottosen – Juniper Vase – tried to keep purple colouring but it disappeared on him.

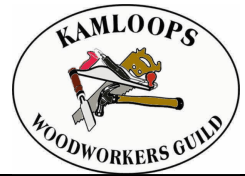


- Denis Biron – Catalpa Vase – beautiful colouring.
