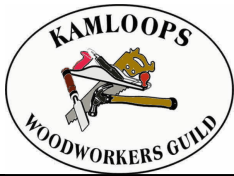

Nic also gave a talk on his Coles Jaws developments.

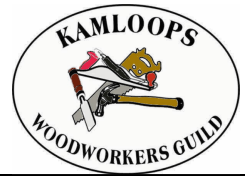
