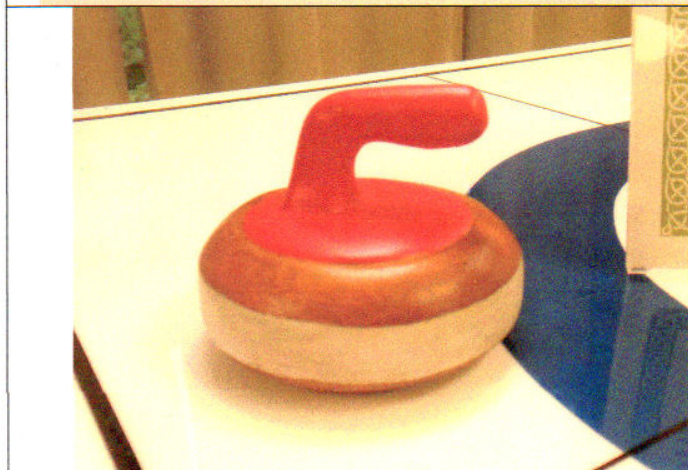
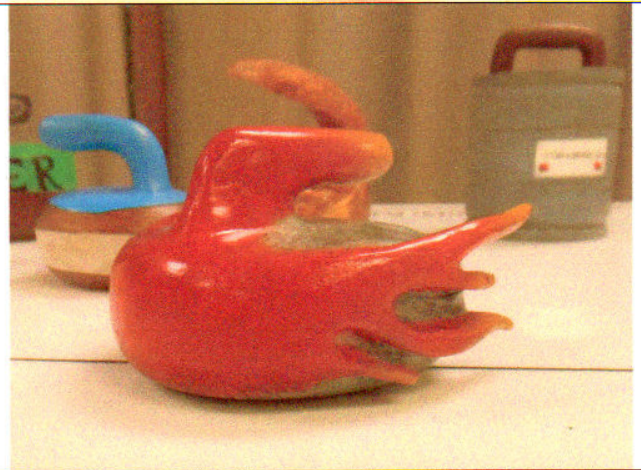

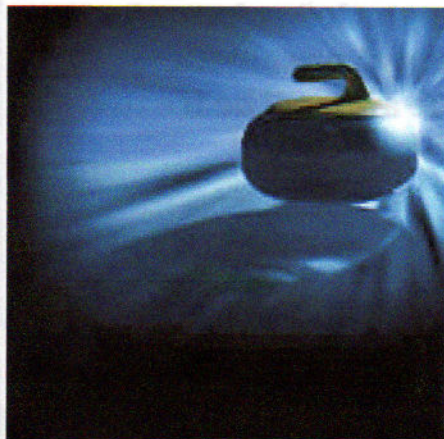

Entries must be boxed, accompanied by an Entry Form, and addressed to Curling Rock Carving Contest. They should be mailed or delivered to 5696 Dallas Drive, Kamloops, BC Canada V2C 4X1, or they may be dropped off at the downtown Kamloops Curling Club office at 700 Victoria Street.

You must sign your carving on its base (your name will be taped over during the judging) -- but leave room for the four Gold Medalist signatures in case you are a winner.

For your carving to be returned to you, it must be accompanied by a prepaid self-addressed return packing slip or an explanation of how it can be returned to you at no cost to Shuswap Carvers Society.

"Sculptures" will be judged and ribbons awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each of the following categories:

- BEST RENDITION (most uniquely realistic);
- MOST ORIGINAL (most quirky or unusual);
- PEOPLE'S CHOICE (by visitors to the Kamloops Curling Club).



Curling rock "sculptures" should be carved in wood or stone (clay also accepted), should measure three 3 inches at the the base (sliding surface), and should have something resembling a handle. The rest is up to your imagination.

The only rules are that your "rock" must be made of wood or stone (clay also acceptable), must have something resembling a handle, and measure 3 inches at its base (the sliding surface).



- ✳️ Sculptures will be judged in February 2014 and 1st, 2nd and 3rd place ribbons will be awarded in each of the following categories: BEST RENDITION (most uniquely realistic), MOST ORIGINAL (most quirky or unusual), and PEOPLE'S CHOICE (as voted on by visitors to the Kamloops Curling Club in February).
- ✳️ Winning sculptures will become part of the 4-corner ice display during the week (March 1-9) of the Tim Hortons Brier and may thus appear on TSN TV.
- ✳️ The winning sculptures will be signed by the 2014 Tim Hortons Brier Medalists.

For those of you who don't know – the Tim Hortons Brier (aka: The Brier) is the Canadian Men's Curling Championship with the Gold Medal team representing Canada at the 2014 World Men's Curling Championship in Beijing, China. Wouldn't it be something special to see your sculpture on national TV and to own a sculpture signed by the 2014 Canadian Men's Curling Champions, and thus possibly the World Champions.
