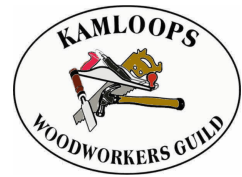

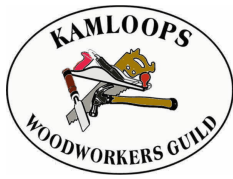

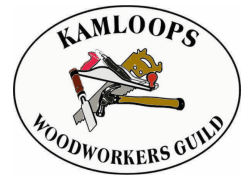
### **CALL TO ORDER:** Sandi Trueman

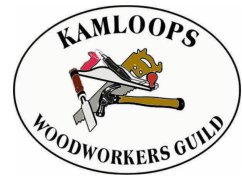

- Dana Manhard – Turned bowl with darker wood edging, two Christmas tree decorations.

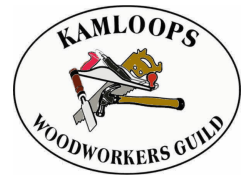

- Gary Harker – Wood puzzles he made for Phsysc Ward at RIH. He is also making a few "touch boards" for them too.

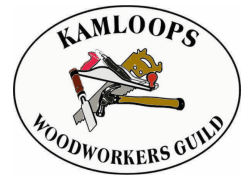

- Denis Biron – Cutting board of walnut and birch built for his daughter-in-law. Lots of fun in the construction process.



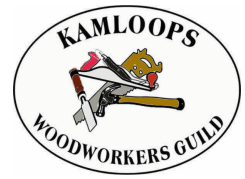
