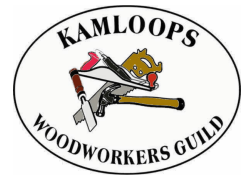

No news yet on April Demo but keep my challenge in mind for show and tell. Doesn't matter what you make but the prez is looking for a 'great' finish!

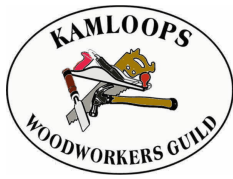
All members please be thinking of Art in the Park sales table...looking for everyone's involvement...have to work as a group.

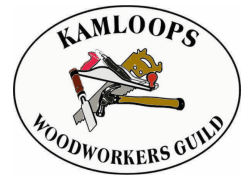
- Sandi called the March meeting to order at 7:00pm.

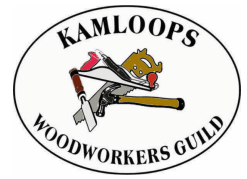
