- Dana M: - Turned flower (wood) holder with sparkly filler in voids... Fancy dyed ear rings for his girls.



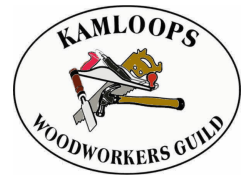
- Dave A: - Two turned pens, two turned bowls from scrap wood he found.

- Tag L: - digging dog cut out for yard display.



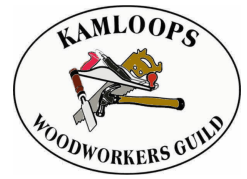
- Victor H: - two cut outs, by scroll saw, of a sea turtle and a owl of juniper wood.

- Gary H: - 4 toy cars and a couple of cribbage boards with large format for older folk.



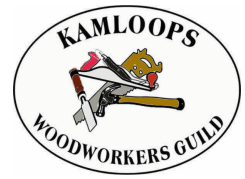
- Sandi T: - a mess of wine stoppers of all different descriptions that she made for a start of her turning journey... Great stories on all of them.
