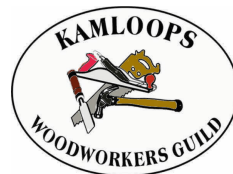
I'd like to thank the members of the executive and all the club members who stood by me during the last two years. I so appreciate your support.
