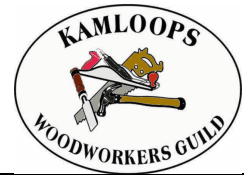

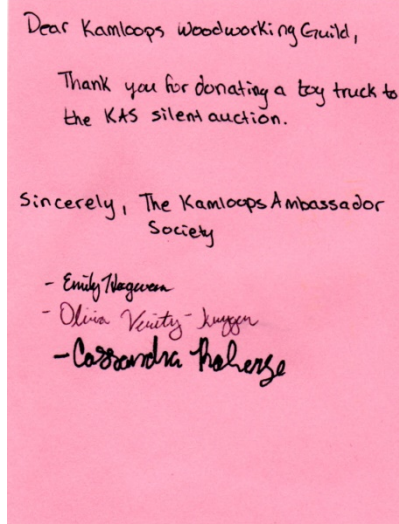

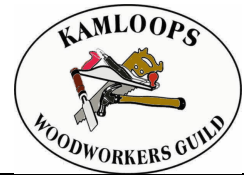
That the KWWG start charging \$1.00 each for Coffee & Cookies at our meetings to help make the coffee fund look after itself.

(Sorry for no photos – I had just returned from vacation trip and forgot camera.)

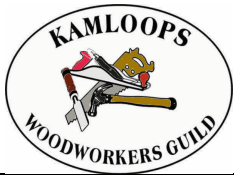
- **Don Gienow** – Turned and weighted fish-bonker. Red oak with ball bearings inside.

- The marquetry picture he was working on last spring, that he showed in a Demo, was present tonight to be started on the finishing process.
- Warren explained the intricate parts of putting the blue on the base board that the picture will be attached to, (reverse side down), and the press that he made to press these pieces together for a few days to let the glue set.
- Then he demo’d the final reveal, with a previously glued-up piece, and it turned out to be his new name tag in marquetry!

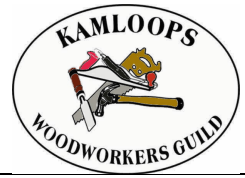
