• Dave Called the April meeting to order at 7:00pm.



CONSTITUTION & BYLAW CHANGES: Carl Ottosen

In accordance with previous meeting notice given to implement changes and improvements to our Constitution and Bylaws and Rules....
We are now at the point where we need to handle these changes, and improvements to our system of governance.

We, the Committee, now move these motions to improve our Governance:

i) Article III - GOVERNANCE:

- ii) By striking out three (3) members "at large", and inserting "minimum of three (3) members"
- iii) By striking out three (3) other directors "at large" and inserting "minimum three (3) other directors".
- viii) By striking out three (3) directors "at large" and inserting minimum three (3) directors.

NEW MOTION FROM COMMITTEE:

Moved that the Membership empowers the Executive to pay Guild's recurring annual expenses which include: rent, insurance, website, arts council and bank fees.

- iv) Feb. 06, 2013 Indemnity clause for Directors.
- v) Sept. 07, 2011 Two (2) choices given to Toymakers to receive funds they chose option 2.

• Warren James – Musical Instrument made from cedar 2x4. Some metal, but all wood is from 2x4. (Neck had to be hardwood.)






• Stu Rockwood – First attempt, with help from Denis, at bowl turning. Bug-killed pine.


- Oak pieces available at front table....
