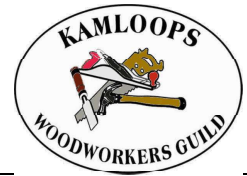

## NEW TOOLS ETC:

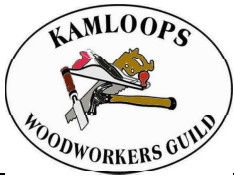

## MEMBERSHIPS: Les

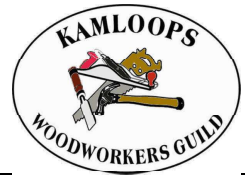
- While Stu is away on vacation, Les Eliason will be collecting membership dues and sheets.

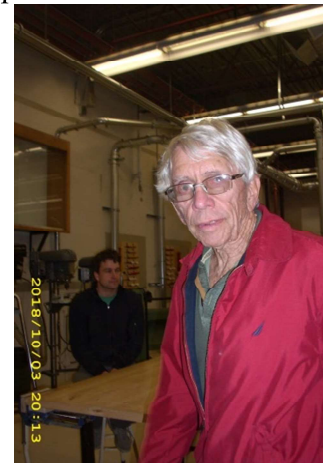
- **WEBSITE** – Intro page needs updating re Executive and Membership cost... Done!

## NEW BUSINESS:

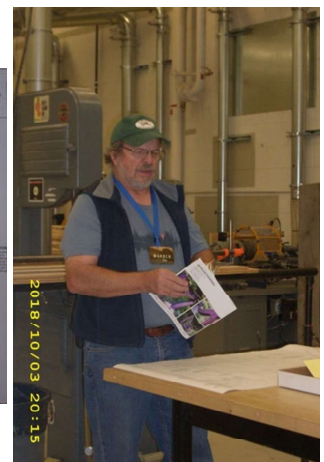

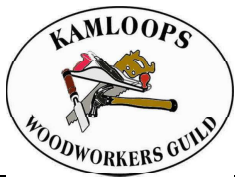
## SHOW & TELL: All

- **Jim Ferguson** – Monster trucks (2) Great looking trucks with paint and names on them.



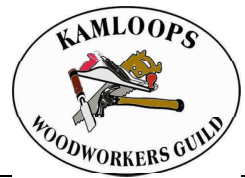
- **Warren James** – Purchased plans for a Dulcimer he plans on making. He has some of the wood already, and the hardware that is needed to finish it.

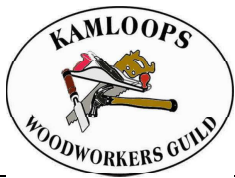
