THANKS: Les E.

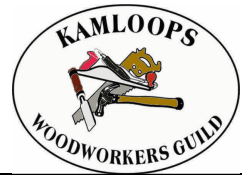
- **Thanks** to Terry Shupe for supplying pre-made toys for Art-In-The-Park this year.

NAMETAG RENEWAL:

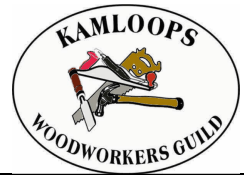
- **It** was suggested that our present name tags were getting shabby looking, and should be renewed this year.

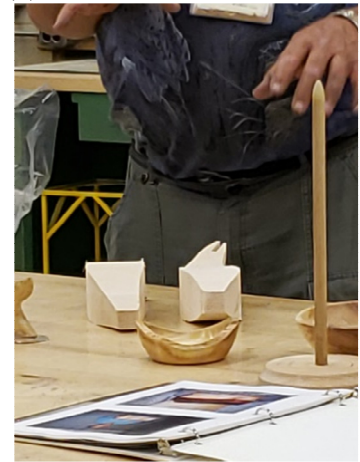
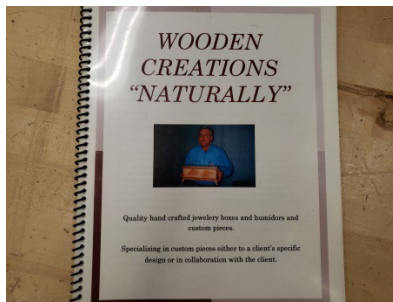
That members renew their name tags, if practicable, for this year's sessions.
