- **Chris Hardy**, on the reserve, has 1 1/4" straps available. Phone him at 778-228-2801.

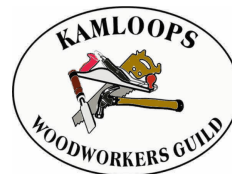

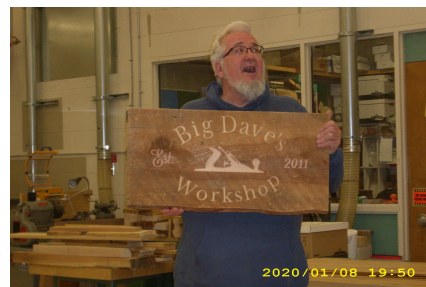

SHOW & TELL:

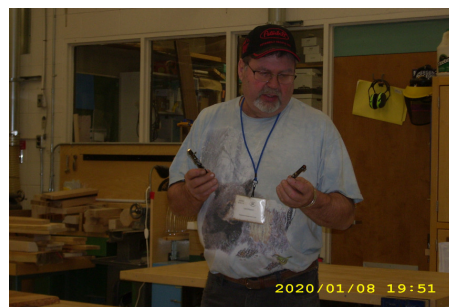
- **Jerry Gauthier** – two picture frames he made. Great work, Jerry.

- **Jerry** gave a very informative lesson on picture framing, and the tools he uses to do it.
- Stock should be a minimum of ¾" thick...
- When mitering corners, you must tape your two opposing sides together and cut the 45°s and this guarantees they'll be perfect length and square.
- Always uses biscuits on each corner. Strong joint, and easy to do.
