Donna & Sharon worked like a well-polished team to give us all the information they could on the art of mixing, colouring, and pouring epoxy resin onto a small sampler board, but would still apply to a larger surface... Just volumes would be different.

Donna had a few boxes of some of her past projects that she did, and showed them around to the crowd, and some were on Styrofoam and were light as feathers. Some were on MDF and skimmed with concrete and then epoxy'd on top to give a smooth, but textured-looking finish.
