
• Dave Gilmour – Presented a book, "The Age Of Wood" – gives the full history of humans using wood from the beginning of time right to the present day...




• **Denis Biron** – Two large Russian Olive turned bowls he rough-turned in 2009, and then let dry, in brown paper bags, didn't touch them until this year.
