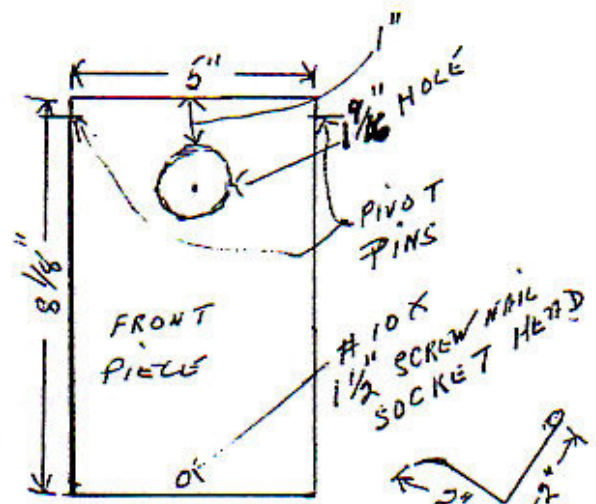
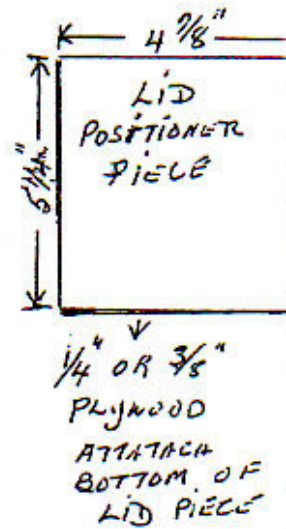
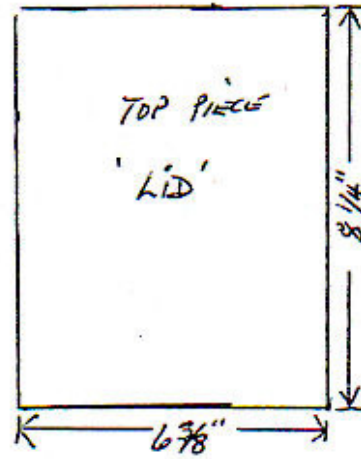
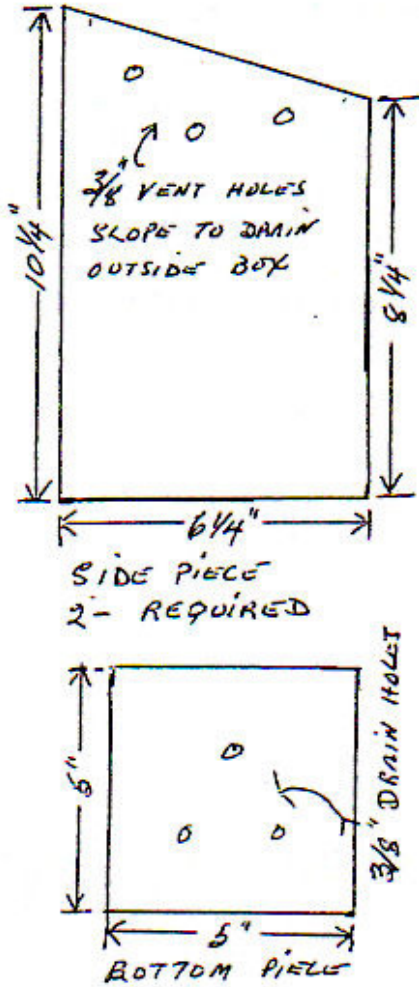
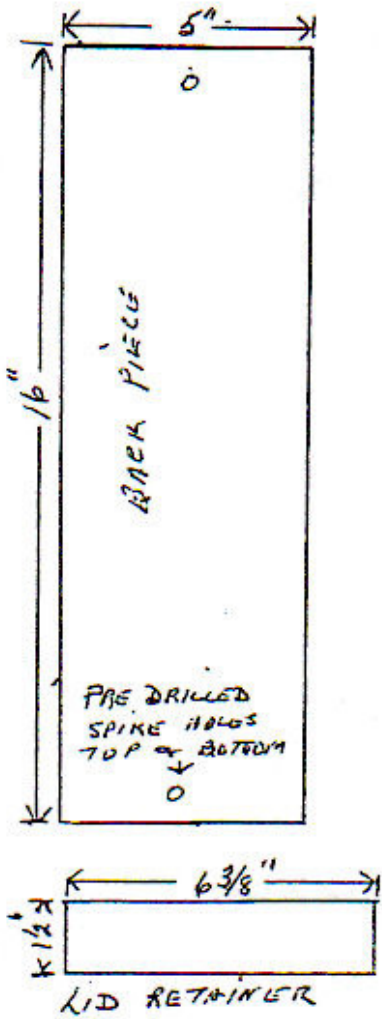


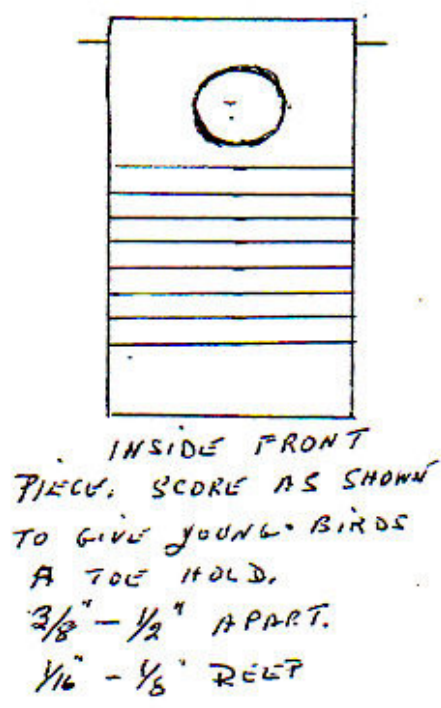
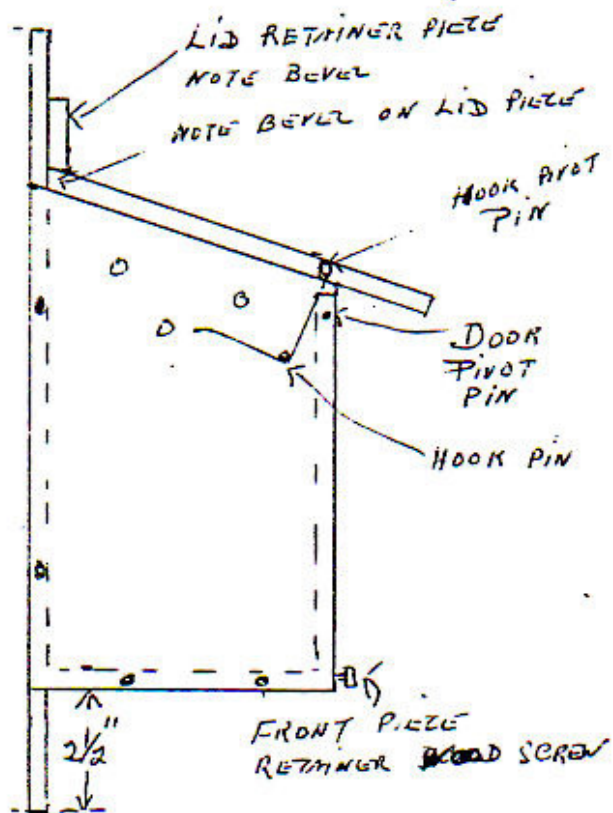
# BLUE BIRD BOX

## BLUEBIRD BOX

### ASSEMBLY NOTES

Start assembly by nailing side pieces to back piece - next nail bottom piece in place and then MOUNT the front piece. (Do not nail this piece!)

- NOTE 1: Front piece width of 5" is exact fit - plane or cut to  $4 \frac{15}{16}$ " for easy fit, or just slightly under 5".
- NOTE 2: In placing door pivot pin, hook pivot pin, and hook pin, drill undersize pilot holes.
- NOTE 3: Front piece pivot pins - use 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ " PC box nails.
- NOTE 4: Suggest 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ " ring nails or 2" spiral nails - spiral preferred - to mount side pieces and bottom, 2 nails as shown.
- NOTE 5: Lid positioner piece - unless a very accurate assembly has been done, some fitting of this piece may be required. So just tack in place until a good fit has been achieved.
- NOTE 6: Lid retainer piece - slide top piece in place and then position lid retainer. Ensure easy fit of top piece - some slack is required because of bevel on retainer piece.
- NOTE 7: Now mount the lid retaining hooks and the box is finished. Use  $\frac{3}{4}$ " roofing nails for hook pin and hook pivot pin.
- NOTE 8: Do not paint. Let it weather and blend in with the natural surroundings.
