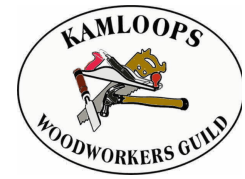

- Jerry Gauthier** – Saw Derry A. a few weeks ago... Still active, looking great.

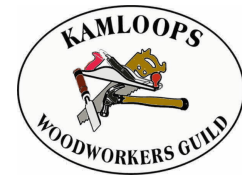
1) TOOLS & WOOD:

- **Jerry G** – two beautiful, colourful cutting boards.

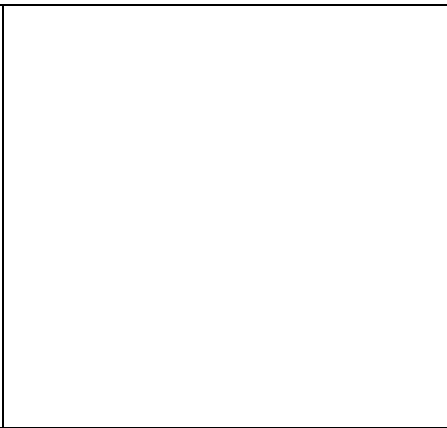

- **Terry S.** – Oak cutting board – odd grain in the white oak.



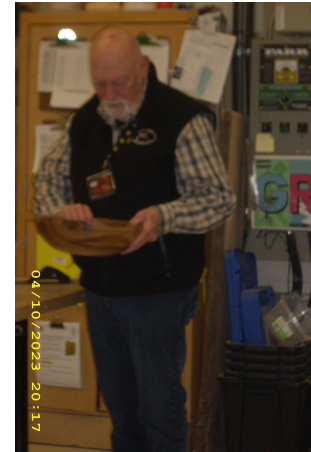
☐ **Nick Smit** – Hand made coffee grinder.



☐ **Don I.** – Bandsaw box of walnut and on order from his daughter...



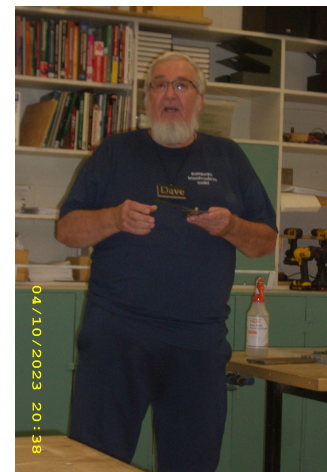
☐ **Denis B.**- Walnut turned bowl (large), and a smaller Walnut turned bowl with felt pen highlight.
