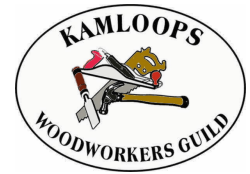

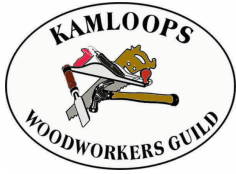

Steve said that the new website is close to being ready. **Chris** is dealing with this, and an update may come next meeting.

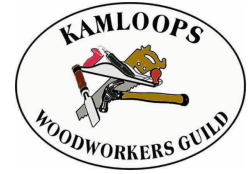
Pat Vickers to host a BBQ Saturday May30th at his house. Address and time provided in next meeting.

- Rob Kelley brought in a couple of walnut epoxy river trays, and also 5 different styles of cutting boards made from a variety of woods.



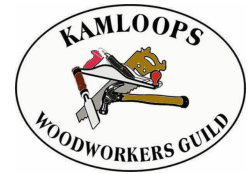

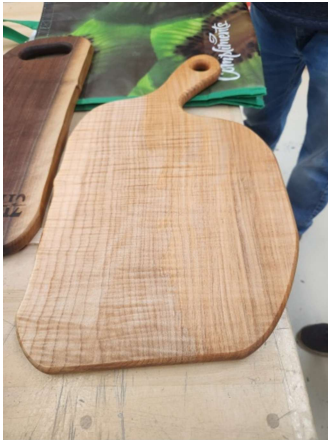
