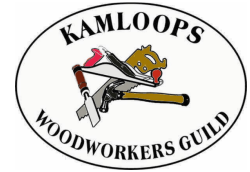

1) **CALL TO ORDER:** Homer H.

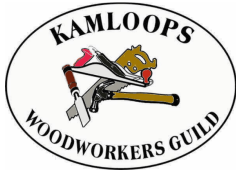
Homer called the meeting to order at **1900**.

- **Eileen Smith** Robin's Wife

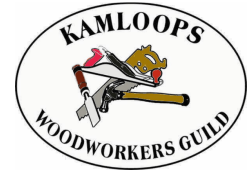
1) **HEALTH & WELFARE:**

- **Pat Vickers** – Will be hosting a BBQ at his house May 30th. Anytime after 11am. 24 Sunset Drive. 250-371-1413

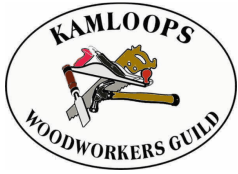
1. SHOW & TELL:

- **Keith** – Brought in some Birch card holders

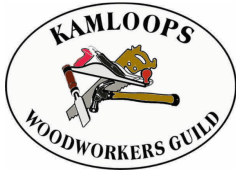


- **Dinyar** – Brought in a Crokinole board he made with Baltic Birch



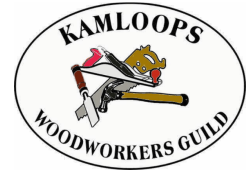
- **Homer** – Brought in a Maple and Walnut box

Nick – Brought in his first three pens. 2 acrylic, and one from Cocobollo

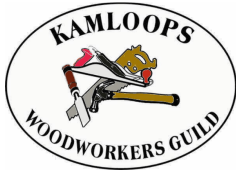


- **Jason** – Brought in a cheese cutter of Curly Maple with a Cherry inlay



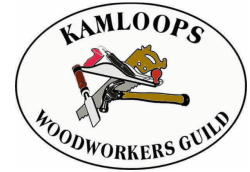
- **Eileen** – Brought in some lace she has made featuring some bobbins that Robin had made for her.
